Cassidy & Zack Co-chairs of SurfRider Concert for the Coast Committee

- Advisor is Stephanie Raya (oversees environmental RCOs)
 - They're not in direct contact w her, but the president is
- Sound technician works with AS and says that AS equipment isn't good enough for the production they want to put on
 - Huge part of success last year was good sound quality
 - Got sound equipment down from 2.5k to 2k
- Last year they only raised about 1.9k, and we gave them 5k
 - Last year it was an open format at the park
 - Didn't press for donations, main source of income was an opportunity drawing (basically a raffle)
 - This year, it's a very heavily encouraged donations (ppl with venmo signs) has been effective in the past
- Not just a fundraiser, also an awareness event and a community event
 - IV locals talking ab how they've been coming to this for a long time
- More experienced bands create a better audience experience even if they aren't already known
 - Club of 40-50 people were excited about the bands

- Reduced budget bc they're pursuing new small community grants, looking for AS to provide security
- Anticipating 1,000-1,500 over the whole day
- Last year there were 2 concerts going on at the same time
- Fundraising goal is: as much as possible, around 10k
 - Possible to match funding we provide them
- Working closely with IVRPD
 - Will be their end of spring concert series finale
 - They can use their shade structure

Discussion:

- Does it matter that they raise more than we give them?
- Abraham: they answered our questions well, seem like they have it together. Good that they're partnering with IVRPD
- Alex: all of our funding is going towards bands, does spending more \$\$ on bands actually lead to more people showing up? I feel like it's more about advertising
- Mulan: yes, I think a good quality band will get people to stay and potentially donate
- Bella: I think it's good that they're fairly compensating their performers
- Abraham: I thought we couldn't fund traveling?
 - David: workaround = we can put that money into the contract cost of hiring the performers
- David: it's good to pay people fairly, but they don't have great reasoning behind why they want to hire these bands
- Vanessa: agree
- Riley: people go to things for just live music, they don't go bc they recognize the name. Why do they need to hire a band for \$3,500, even if that's what the band is worth
- David: partial funding, around 5k-5.5k
- Bella: they can still have an event with this money
- Abraham: and fundraising more than 5k would be easier
